## MEMORANDUM SUMMARY

This guidance supersedes GM 20-03 #2 GM, released March 17, 2020 regarding suspension of NH congregate meals. The purpose of this memorandum is to provide nutrition agencies with guidance and resources to assist in their decision for safe opening and closing of congregate meal sites during COVID-19 emergency. This guidance is not intended as a mandate to reopen congregate dining sites.

The Bureau of Elderly and Adult Services is sharing the following information for agencies to consider as they prepare for the future return to congregate dining, referred to by CMS as communal dining. Contracted service providers for Title III and Title XX nutrition programs choosing to open a communal dining site should ensure that the agency's decision is consistent with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Long Term Care Facilities (LTCF) Reopening Guidance for communal dining –a phased and county-based approach adopted by the New Hampshire Division of Public Health Services (DPHS).
