Right to Report

If you or someone you know is experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, the John H. Sununu Youth Services Center (SYSC) wants to know. We want you to report right away, because:

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

How To Report

SYSC offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously*.

- Call DCYF Central Intake at 1 (800) 894-5533 (in-state) or (603) 271-6556 (out-of-state); or
The YWCA at (603) 668-2299;
The Office of the Child Advocate at (603) 271-7773 or (833) NHCHILD;
Access TDD or TTY services for the hearing impaired at 1 (800) 735-2964 or 7-1-1
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip.
- Report to the Office of the Ombudsman.
- Report to the PREA coordinator or PREA compliance manager.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling DCYF Central Intake at 1 (800) 894-5533 (in-state) or (603) 271-6556 (out-of-state).
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.

Victim Support Services

SYSC has partnered with the YWCA to provide survivors of sexual abuse with emotional support services. To access these services, call (603) 668-2299 or send a letter to: YWCA, 72 Concord St, Manchester, NH 03101.
