Case Law

This policy defines the required practices for seeking detention of a youth who is alleged to have committed a new delinquency offense, or violation of conditional release or court orders pursuant to RSA 169-B.

Required Practices

Any deviations to the following information must be documented with Supervisory Approval.

- I. JPPOs must always consider alternatives to detention when a youth is alleged to have committed a new delinquency offense or violation of conditional release/court orders to the degree that the youth cannot meet a standard of safety or are not safe due to their own actions.
 - A. JPPOs will assist law enforcement upon request in considering alternatives to detention and completing the Detention Assessment Screening Instrument as appropriate.
- II. If non-secure options are not appropriate and the JPPO (or law enforcement when assisting) is seeking secure detention, the JPPO will:
 - A. Contact local law enforcement to gather relevant law enforcement history to complete the tool;
 - B. Confirm there will be a new petition or violation;
 - C. Check the DCYF electronic information system for relevant information; and
 - D. Complete the Detention Assessment Screening Instrument (Court Form NHJB-2581-DF) to determine eligibility.
- III. The JPPO will submit the Detention Assessment Screening Instrument along with the appropriate documentation to the Court.
- IV. The Detention Assessment Screening Instrument must be maintained in the case file.
