Maintaining a safe pool environment depends on properly trained people. The American Red Cross Water Safety and/or Lifeguard Course is the minimum accepted level of training to qualify a person to supervise residents in the pool at the SYSC.

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish the water safety-training requirement for utilization of the Sununu Youth Services Center pool.

Policy

- I. Certified Pool Supervisors: A staff member who has been certified in the American Red Cross Water Safety/Lifeguard Course, or equivalent, shall directly supervise swimming pool activities of SYSC residents or juveniles from any other organization.
- II. Pool Supervisor List: A list of qualified employees shall be posted in the gymnasium and at the swimming pool and maintained in the Supervisor's Office.
