In support of its commitment to restorative justice, the SYSC will develop and offer to residents a wide range of community service activities that can be conducted both on and off the Youth Development Center Campus (YDC Campus).

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish the community service procedure for residents.

Policy

- I. Community Service Development: To ensure that all committed residents have the opportunity to participate in community service, activities shall be developed that will involve residents who are restricted to the YDC Campus. Such activities could include, but are not limited to:
 - A. Campus service and beautification (landscaping, gardens, assistance with care of grounds).
 - B. Fund raising activities for national or community causes.
 - C. Creation of craft or other items for donation to appropriate community organizations.
- II. Community Service for Committed Residents: SYSC shall provide the opportunity for committed residents who are not restricted to the YDC Campus to perform service activities in the community. Such activities could include, but are not limited to:
 - A. Service to community organizations such as food pantries, soup kitchens, homeless shelters, hospitals, and churches.
 - B. Service to individuals such as YDC neighbors or community members in need.
- III. Bureau Chief Responsibility: The development of community service activities shall be the responsibility of the Bureau Chief of Residential Services or designee.
