





## **TUITION WAIVER FOR FOSTER CHILDREN PROGRAM**

The University System of New Hampshire and the Community College System of New Hampshire have partnered with the New Hampshire Division for Children, Youth and Families to provide tuition waivers to eligible students, enabling them to obtain a certificate, associate degree, or bachelor's degree through either of these systems of higher education. Each system will provide a maximum of 35 tuition/fee waivers to eligible students each year. **Students are required to apply for this assistance annually.** 

### **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicant must be under 26 years of age as of May 1st prior to the academic year for which aid is sought and is or was:

- (a) In state foster care for the immediate 6-month period prior to his or her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday;
- (b) In state guardianship or custody at the time of his or her 18th birthday;
- (c) In guardianship, after being in state foster care or guardianship, at the time of their 18th birthday. To qualify for the waiver through this eligibility category, you must attach a certificate of guardianship that shows you were in guardianship at the time of your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday with your application.
- (d) In placement out-of-state, through the interstate compact for the placement of children, at the time of their 18th birthday. To qualify for the waiver through this eligibility category, you must indicate your living arrangement at the time of your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday in the space below. For example, I was living with my Aunt in Massachusetts.
- (e) Adopted while in state guardianship or adopted from the care, custody, and control of the department following a surrender or termination of parental rights; or
- (f) In an out-of-home placement under the supervision of the division for juvenile justice services at the time of his or her 18th birthday.

The attached Application Form and Signature Page must be completed and submitted to the New Hampshire Division for Children, Youth and Families. Preference is given to applications received before May 1<sup>st</sup> each year. It is important for you to complete your 'packaging requirements' for the college you are interested in attending *as soon as possible* as delays may impact our ability to consider your application. Individuals who have been approved for a tuition waiver will be notified typically by June 30<sup>th</sup>.

In order to receive Federal Financial Aid, applicants are required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Please visit <a href="https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa">https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</a> for information and to complete this process. Questions specific to this process can also be answered by the Financial Aid Office at the college you plan to attend. Failure to complete the FAFSA will result in an incomplete tuition waiver application and will prevent eligibility for a tuition waiver.

#### **Participating Colleges and Websites**

The University System of New Hampshire and the Community College System of New Hampshire will each grant up to 35 awards annually through this program. Applicants are encouraged to apply to institutions within both Systems to increase the likelihood of being selected for a tuition waiver. Please contact the institution(s) of your choice to find out key information regarding application, registration, and enrollment deadlines.
